

Politician Scandal Privacy Policy

Protecting your privacy is important to Politician Scandal.

This Privacy Policy explains how Politician Scandal collects, uses, and discloses the personal information you may provide while using PoliticianScandal.com (the "Website") and the services provided through any of the Website. It is always your choice whether or not to provide personal information through the Website. Any personal information you provide will be treated in accordance with this Privacy Policy.

Your Consent

1. By using or submitting information to this Website, you consent to Politician Scandal' collection, use, and disclosure of your personal information in accordance with this Privacy Policy. If you do not agree with this Privacy Policy, you may not use or submit personal information to the Website.

Information Automatically Collected

2. *Non-Personal Information* - As is typical with many other Internet sites, the Website automatically collects certain non-personal information regarding users, such as the date and time you access the Website, your IP address, the URL from which you linked to the Website, the operating system you are using, the Website pages read and images viewed, and any content you post to the Website. This non-personal information is used for Website and system administration purposes. Non-personal information may be disclosed to others and permanently archived for future use.

3. *Cookies* - The Website uses "cookies," a technology that stores a small amount of information on a user's computer to permit the Website to recognize future visits using that computer. Cookies enhance the convenience and use of the Website. For example, the information provided through cookies is used to recognize you as a previous user of the Website (so you do not have to enter your personal information every time), offer personalized content and information for your use and otherwise facilitate your Website experience.

Some of the banner ads displayed in the Website are provided by outside companies. These ads contain cookies. While Politician Scandal uses cookies in other parts of the Website, cookies received with banner ads are collected by Politician Scandal' advertisers and Politician Scandal does not have access to this information. Politician Scandal may engage third parties to provide cookies that collect information regarding Website use. You may choose to decline cookies generally if your browser permits, but doing so may affect your use of the Website and your ability to access certain features of the Website.

Personal Information You Specifically Provide

4. *Your Personal Information* - During your use of the Website, you may be asked to voluntarily provide personal information (such as your name, e-mail address, and address) for communications with you. If you choose not to provide certain requested personal information, you may not be able to use certain features of

the Website.

5. Use of Your Personal Information – Politician Scandal may use your personal information to contact and correspond with you, respond to your communications, provide services to you, facilitate and enhance your use of the Website, and as otherwise permitted by law. Additionally, Politician Scandal may keep a record of all communications with you.

Politician Scandal uses third-party advertising companies to serve ads when you visit its Website. These companies may use information (not including your name, address, email address or telephone number) about your search queries and visits to the Website and other websites in order to provide advertisements about goods and services of interest to you. You should be aware that if you voluntarily disclose information online (whether through Politician Scandal's services or any other service available online), personal or otherwise, that information can be collected and used by others. For example, if you use forums or if you post personal information online, you may receive unsolicited messages from others. Politician Scandal has no control over this use of your personal information.

Politician Scandal allows its users to send articles or links by email to other parties who may be interested in them. Politician Scandal does not retain any email addresses of either the sender or recipient of such articles or links after they are sent.

6. E-mails from Politician Scandal - If you register as a Politician Scandal member, then Politician Scandal may send to you, from time to time, e-mail or other communications containing information about Politician Scandal and other matters that Politician Scandal believes will interest you. At any time you may ask Politician Scandal to stop sending you e-mail by sending your request by e-mail to info@PoliticianScandal.com. Also, each e-mail Politician Scandal sends to you will tell you how to decline further unsolicited e-mail.

7. Disclosure of Your Personal Information – Politician Scandal may disclose your personal information in the following circumstances and as otherwise permitted by applicable law:

a. Disclosure to Authorizing Persons - If you use the Website on behalf of another person or organization (such as your employer), Politician Scandal may provide your personal information to that authorizing person/organization. Politician Scandal has no control over the use of your personal information by the authorizing person/organization, and that use is not subject to this Privacy Policy.

b. Disclosure to Politician Scandal Business Associates – Politician Scandal may provide your personal information to its affiliated businesses, advertisers, or suppliers and service providers for use in connection with the operation of the Website. Politician Scandal may also disclose your personal information to service providers who analyze website use. Politician Scandal requires its affiliated businesses, advertisers, suppliers and service providers to agree to use your personal information only for the purposes for which it is provided to them, and to protect the privacy of your personal information in a manner that is consistent with this Privacy Policy.

c. Disclosure in Business Transfers - Politician Scandal may be involved in the sale or transfer of some or all of its business. As part of that sale or transfer, Politician Scandal may disclose your personal information to the acquiring organization, but will require the acquiring organization to agree to protect the privacy of your

personal information in a manner that is consistent with this Privacy Policy. Politician Scandal shall assume no liability for the acquiring organization's use and disclosure of your personal information. If at any time you do not wish Politician Scandal to disclose your personal information as part of the sale or transfer of some or all of its business, please send your request by e-mail to info@PoliticianScandal.com.

d. Law Enforcement and Legal Disclosure - Politician Scandal may disclose your personal information to a government institution that has asserted its lawful authority to obtain the information or where Politician Scandal has reasonable grounds to believe the information could be useful in the investigation of unlawful activity, or to comply with a subpoena or warrant or an order made by a court, person or body with jurisdiction to compel the production of information, or to comply with court rules regarding the production of records and information, or to its legal counsel. Politician Scandal has no control over, or liability for, those persons' use and disclosure of your personal information, and that use and disclosure is not subject to this Privacy Policy.

8. Depersonalized Information - Politician Scandal may use personal information to create non-personal information regarding the use of the Website and related services. Politician Scandal may then disclose that non-personal information to other persons and permanently archive that non-personal information for future use.

9. Business Contact Information - To the extent permitted by law, the provisions of this Privacy Policy concerning "personal information" do not apply to information which enable you to be contacted at a place of business, such as your job position or title, business address, business telephone number, business fax number and business e-mail address.

10. Location of Information - Politician Scandal will store and process your personal information in Vancouver, British Columbia, Canada.

11. Securing Your Information - To help protect the confidentiality of your personal information, Politician Scandal employs reasonable security safeguards appropriate to the sensitivity of the information. Nevertheless, security risks cannot be eliminated and Politician Scandal cannot guarantee that your personal information will not be used or disclosed in ways not otherwise described in this Policy.

12. Accessing Your Personal Information - You may request access to your personal information and information about Politician Scandal's collection, use and disclosure of that information by sending your request by e-mail to info@PoliticianScandal.com. Subject to certain exceptions prescribed by law, you will be given reasonable access to your personal information within a reasonable time, and to amend it as appropriate. Politician Scandal attempts to keep its records as accurate and complete as possible.

13. Other Websites - The Website may contain links to other sites or internet resources. When you click on one of those links you are contacting another website. Politician Scandal has no responsibility or liability for or control over those other websites or their collection, use and disclosure of your personal information.

14. Terms and Conditions - The [Politician Scandal Terms and Conditions](#) agreement contains important provisions, including provisions disclaiming, limiting or excluding Politician Scandal's liability for your use of the Website and provisions determining the applicable law and exclusive jurisdiction for the resolution of any

disputes regarding the Website. Each of those provisions applies to any disputes that may arise in relation to this Privacy Policy or Politician Scandal' collection, use and disclosure of your personal information, and shall be of the same force and effect as if they had been reproduced directly in this Privacy Policy.

15. Former Users - If you stop using the Website or your permission to use the Websites is terminated, Politician Scandal may continue to use and disclose your personal information in accordance with this Privacy Policy.

16. Policy Changes - To accommodate changes in the Website, changing technology, and legal developments, this Policy may be changed from time to time at Politician Scandal' sole discretion and without any prior notice to you. New versions of this Privacy Policy will be posted here. Synthetic Womb's collection, use and disclosure of personal information will be governed by the version of this Privacy Policy in effect at that time.

Your continued dealings with Politician Scandal or your use of the Website subsequent to any changes to this Policy will signify your consent to the collection, use and disclosure of your personal information in accordance with the changed Privacy Policy.
